



**SUMMER INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY IN BELFAST
DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 1, 2025**

The Brehon Law Society of New York and leading Belfast-based human rights law firm **KRW Law LLP** are pleased to announce that, for the tenth summer in a row, are accepting applications for a unique and prestigious three-month summer internship opportunity for a current law student this coming Summer 2026 in the North of Ireland. The internship dates are about late May through mid-August.

The intern will be placed in KRW Law's Legacy Litigation Department, which will provide firsthand exposure to the challenges of litigating in a post-conflict setting. The 2026 Summer Intern should have interest in and knowledge of political issues in the North of Ireland and be familiar with The Troubles. An overall interest in human rights and activism is preferred.

Internship responsibilities include keeping the Brehon membership informed on current human rights issues and legal controversies in the North, particularly around Legacy Litigation and the Good Friday Agreement; legal research; legal writing; litigation support, such as drafting correspondence and document review; litigation observation; participation in local community events and outreach; and assisting in the development of press releases and web postings for Brehon members and media outlets.

Applications must include all of the following to be considered:

1. Cover letter with a personal statement demonstrating why you are interested in the internship;
2. A resume/CV;
3. A writing sample;
4. List of three (3) references ;
5. Grade sheet/transcript (unofficial is acceptable, and can be submitted on a rolling basis as available)

A committee comprised of Brehon lawyers will review all materials, and selected candidates must be available for Zoom interviews between November 10 and 21, 2025. All questions about the internship and application process can be directed to Caitríona Fox at caitrionatfox@gmail.com.

KRW Law LLP will offer a stipend. The Brehon Law Society will provide round-trip airfare between the U.S. and Belfast as well as housing and visa expenses. The selected intern will be expected to complete travel/visa requirements prior to their start date to ensure capability to intern abroad.
